November 5, 2024 General Election:

Unofficially had a 79.86% turnout

17,317 voters came out and voted on election day

4,331 voted by an absentee/mail-in ballot

70 Provisional ballots were counted at final count and 14 denied for not being registered in
Tioga County

Total Ballots Cast: 21,718 out of 27,195 registered voters

The election office received approximately 501 phone calls on election day.
