- Joel Hersh SART Executive Director
 - o "FEMA looks at Pennsylvania's volunteer animal program as a national model"
 - o Virtually every emergency affects animals somehow
 - o CART started in 2005
 - 85 to 100 incidents a year throughout the state
 - Most of which are small incidents
 - o Idea came from a North Carolina concept based off of a flood they had
 - Goals
 - Decrease the threat to humans and animals
 - CARTs should do a lot of show and tell
 - Prevent and decrease spread of disease
 - Minimize economic impact of animal emergencies
 - Ag is Pennsylvania's largest economy (\$4 billion to \$6 billion each year)
 - Code of Conduct
 - Everyone must sign it
 - Resources
 - 3 mobile shelter units (one in each PEMA region)
 - HVAC, water supply, mobile stalls, generator
 - Closest to us is located in Carlisle, Cumberland County
 - Can hold up to 25 animals
 - One side is cats/small dogs, other side is larger animals
 - PIMAS request We would have to come get it

- Donations
 - Go to Harrisburg Airport but earmarked for CART that was named in donation
 - Current SART budget is \$140,000 per year out of PEMA
- Integrated Animal Disaster Teams
 - Any animal, any disaster, anywhere
 - Game Commission handles wild animals
- County Plans
 - Evacuation of animals
 - Sheltering of animals
 - Instructions for care of those left behind
 - Support for disease eradication
 - Quarantine, euthanasia, disposal
 - PennAg Industries
 - Lead effort on swine and getting farmers to have emergency plans
 - Counseling For responders
 - DEP for animal carcass burying locations
 - Build out ICS chart for CART responses
 - Field Ops VMATs no longer exist
 - Assessment, request resources, ID health and safety issues, expertise to counties
 - Search and Rescue
 - Pick up lost or injured animals, evacuate animals, assist human resources
 - EOC Plan Add CART representation
 - CART Add water rescue to CART plan
- PA has 186,000,000 poultry birds, 1.5 million deer, 1.64 million cattle, 2 million cats, 2 million dogs
- Equine industry is \$1.5 billion
- SART Board Policies (must be signed prior to membership)
 - Code of Conduct
 - Anti-Discrimination Policy
 - Wavier of Liability
- SART Insurance
 - Individual Liability Insurance 250 seats purchased each year
 - Medical Insurance Backup to help with deductibles and co-pays
 - General Liability Insurance if something gets damaged/destroyed
- Board of Directors
 - Currently going through changes
 - Joel is trying to retire and has been for a while now
- CART Elections

 - Lead meetings, lead planning of CART response plan
