2. Josh Battin and Rebecca Parks from Meadowlark Counseling then presented their request for financial assistance in attending a conference for the amount of \$2,000. Both left after presenting.
3. Laurie Roof and Mike Spencer presented a proposal for a second Harbor House in the amount of \$45,270.00. Mike and Laurie then left the meeting.
